## Chemical Science 3/4LA – Solids and Liquids








In 3/4LA we have been learning about Liquids and Solids. We have learnt that different solids need heat to melt and have different melting points. Ice has a lower melting point than chocolate.

We also learnt that liquids have different freezing points. Wax has a much higher freezing point than water.


When they go from solid to liquids the molecules inside spread apart and when they move from liquid to solid the molecules move closer together.

**Bus Route Start** 







## Staying safe from mosquitoes

After floods and heavy rainfall, mosquitoes can grow and spread in the pools of water left behind.

While the overall risk is low, some mosquitoes carry diseases that are spread through mosquito bites. Mosquitoes are more active at dusk and dawn, but some will also bite during the day.

The best way to prevent mosquito-borne diseases is to avoid mosquito bites.

Families can protect against mosquito bites by:

- covering up as much as possible with long, loose-fitting, light-coloured clothing
- applying insect repellent that contains picaridin or DEET on exposed skin when leaving home
- limiting outdoor activity if lots of mosquitoes are active.

At this stage we will stay in Clunes this week as I don't think I'll be able to get the bus. Please let me know if you require care (you don't need to be a working family to use this service, but working families have priority over care).

#### **Holiday Program**

I'm offering a few days of care each week during these 2 weeks of the January School Holidays, **9**<sup>th</sup> **to 12**<sup>th</sup> and **16**<sup>th</sup> **to 19**<sup>th</sup> **of January** (If I get the numbers). We are hoping to go Ten Pin Bowling in Ballarat, Movies in Maryborough, Horse Riding in Daylesford and Extreme Bounce in Ballarat.

Hours of operation will be 8am to 5.30pm, no part days. Excursions usually take place between 10am and 4pm, remainder of the time we are back at the school doing crafts, cooking, playing games, riding scooters, or just hanging out in the playground. Charges are your usual hourly rate x 9.5 hours care plus excursion costs. We use the Daylesford FDC Bus, it fitted with appropriate seatbelts and booster seats as required.
