 - 2 x Junior School Council Meetings were conducted incorporating Student Voice into decision making within the school
 - Staff actively participated in OH & S Meetings and our staff anaphylaxis management competencies were completed thanks to Liz and Jan.
 - Parent and Staff Opinion Surveys were conducted

 - School Musical preparation has begun – I cannot wait to see the finished product!
 - 2 x School Council Meetings were conducted (1 more tonight!)
 - Major Games tournament was held with some successful Football, Netball, Soccer and Newcombe teams
