CHAPLAIN'S CHAT

An Attitude of Gratitude: This is what research tells us about having an attitude of gratitude:

- Higher levels of positive emotions, life satisfaction, vitality, optimism
- Lower levels of depression and stress.
- Grateful people tend to be more empathic and able to take the perspective of others
- They are rated as more generous and more helpful by people in their social networks
- Relationships with family and friends are more likely to be loving and supportive when gratitude is expressed
- Grateful individuals place less importance on material goods; and
- They are less likely to judge their own and others' success in terms of possessions accumulated; they are less envious of wealthy people.

Who would not want these benefits to be prevalent in our families and society? I want to challenge you to consider how you can instil a *culture of gratitude* into your own life, your family, your community. I believe it is a simple concept, but has the power to really change lives.
